TITLE: Assistive Technology Policy

Assistive technology devices and assistive technology services, or both, are readily available to a child with a disability if it is required as part of the child's IEP. If staff members need assistance with assistive technology resources or additional training, this will be provided by the Capital Area Intermediate Unit.

Hearing aids worn in school by children with hearing impairments, including deafness, are to be maintained for proper functioning. The school nurse is responsible for the maintained of all hearing aids. If staff needs assistance with hearing aid resources or additional training, this will be provided by the Capital Area Intermediate Unit. The nurse will review and receive additional training to maintain proper functioning of hearing aids.
