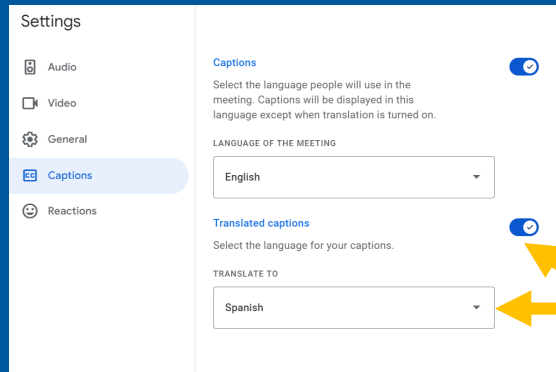
To enable translated captions in Google Meet

From a mobile device:

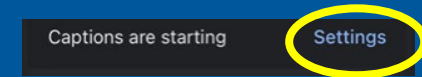
1. Click on **More** icon.



2. Click **Show captions**



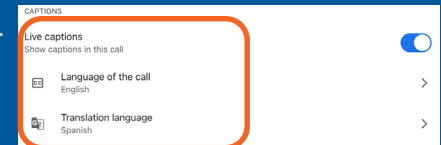
3. Choose **Settings**.

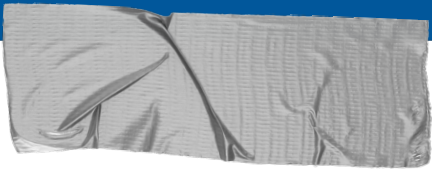


4. Turn on **Live Translation**; choose Language.

The mission of Sylvan Heights Science Charter School is to enhance children's lives through educational experiences that are grounded in a comprehensive, science-driven interdisciplinary program highlighting discovery and creativity.

Updated Funding Levels for SY 2023 -2024

Title IA – \$152, 161, a decrease of \$7,497 (4.9%)

- estimated allocation for 2023 -2024 was \$159, 658
- 2022-2023 allocation was \$165,981

Title IIA – \$11,842, a decrease of \$471 (4.0%)

- estimated allocation for 2023 -2024 was \$12,313
- 2022-2023 allocation was \$13,054

Title IVA - \$12,994 (remained the same)

- 2022-2023 allocation was \$13,323

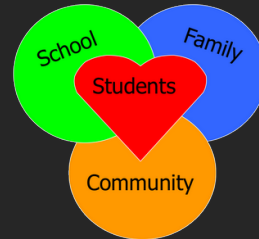

Planning for Title I, II, IV in SY 2024 – 2025

- **ARP ESSER funds end 9/30/2024**
- Title I is a 100% Federally funded supplemental education program designed to help children meet the state content and performance standards in reading, language arts, and mathematics. In buildings with 40% or more poverty, LEAs may use the funds to upgrade the entire curriculum of the school and are Schoolwide Programs.
- ***Once you stop use of funds for program support, you may not restart use for the same expense the following year.***

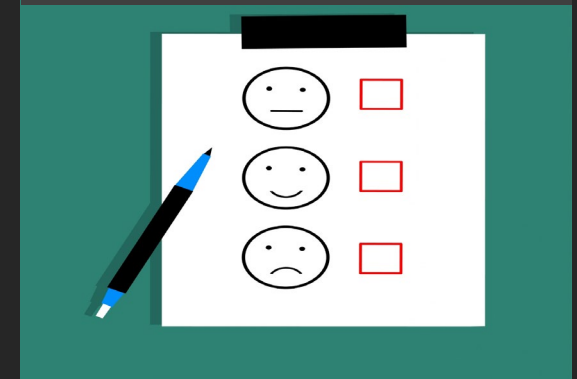
